GROUND BREAKING CEREMONY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AGRO-INDUSTRIAL PROCESSING ZONE



Vice President Kashim Shettima recently performed the groundbreaking for the construction of Special Agro-Industrial Processing Zone (SAPZ) in Kaduna State. The initiative is a large national programme that includes Kaduna, Kano, Kwara, Cross River, Imo, Ogun, Oyo, and the Federal Capital Territory (FCT) among states in the first phase of the project. The Kaduna SAPZ is one of the eight across Nigeria being developed with support from the African Development Bank (ADB), Islamic Development Bank (IDB), and the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD). The project is designed to attract private sector investment in agro-industrial processing, create agro-industrial hubs and enhance rural development. It will also strengthen Nigeria's agricultural ecosystem to respond favourably to current challenges in the sector. The zones are designed to integrate farmers with processors, reduce post-harvest losses and expand economic opportunities in rural communities. While addressing stakeholders at the vast expanse of land designated for the facility in Daki-Takwas, along Kaduna - Abuja Expressway, Chikun Local Government Area of Kaduna State, the Vice President described the SAPZ as a presidential priority project and a direct response to the longstanding challenges facing Nigeria's agricultural value chain, including poor infrastructure, limited access to markets, and low value addition. He expressed confidence that the initiative will catalyze economic growth by creating thousands of jobs and empowering Nigerian youths. Senator Shettima further explained that with the commencement of work on the project, the Government is building a future where agriculture will feed the people and drive national prosperity. Goodwill messages were delivered by President of African Development Bank, Dr. Akinwumi Adesina and the Governor of Kaduna State, Sen. Uba Sani. Other notable dignitaries who attended the event include the Deputy Governor of Kaduna State, Dr. Hadiza Sabuwa Balarabe; Minister of Agriculture and Food Security, Senator Abubakar Kyari; Minister of State for Industry, Trade and Investment, Sen. John Enoh; Emir of Zazzau, Ambassador Ahmed Nuhu Bamalli; the National Project Coordinator of SAPZ, Dr. Kabir Yusuf and so many other dignitaries.

FG LAUNCHES NATIONAL LIVESTOCK TRANSFORMATION PROGRAMME



The Minister of Livestock Development, Mr. Idi Maiha, recently launched the National Livestock Transformation Programme at one of the Grazing Reserve in Wase Local Government Area of Plateau State. The ambitious initiative is aimed at revolutionizing livestock farming across Nigeria. The Minister who inaugurated the programme during a visit to the reserve, described it as part of Federal Government's Renewed Hope Agenda to essentially create a value chain in the livestock industry. He explained that the grazing reserve covers about 100 hectares and will accommodate more than 20,000 cattle. With such a large number, there will be significant milk production, which will, in turn, attract milk processing companies to establish outlets in the area. The Minister noted that red meat processing factories will also set up cold rooms in the area. Additionally, the solid waste from the animals will be harnessed to generate electricity and serve as organic fertilizer for farmers. Mr. Maiha further explained that the Ministry will construct mass housing for the herders and their families and earth dams for dry season irrigation of pasture so that the animals will have no reason to leave to another place for greener pastures. The Ministry will also construct and equip veterinary clinics for the health of the animals and primary healthcare clinics for the families of the herders. The Minister assured that road networks would be constructed within the grazing reserve as part of the programme's infrastructure development. Speaking further, Mr. Maiha said the reserve along with others will support the livestock sector and stimulate the economy by attracting various agribusinesses. He also stated that the project will rely on renewable energy so as to avoid issues of climate change. The Minister further stated that his visit was aimed at engaging critical stakeholders to ensure the smooth commencement of the Programme.

NIGERIA'S apex capital market regulator, Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), has affirmed that registration with the Commission is the sole determinant of legitimacy or otherwise of an investment scheme. Director General, Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Dr Enomotimi Agema, warned Nigerians to beware of firms that claim that the registration of their companies with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) and SCUML certificate from the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) have empowered them to operate investment schemes in Nigeria.

Speaking on the sidelines of a sensitisation tour against a Ponzi scheme at the Garki Market, yesterday in Abuja, Agema said it was disheartening that some Nigerians are coming out to the people. "We are using this sensitisation outreach to bring information to our people and that is why we are here and telling them that we are here to assist them to confirm legitimate investment schemes and we are letting them know we feel their pain."

"We have seen many Ponzi schemes in the past, and the Investments and Securities Act had been signed into law by the President and the law recommends N20 million fine and 10 years imprisonment for offenders of Ponzi Scheme."

Court sentences man to 1-year jail over N16.6m fraud

Justice Olubusola Okunuga of the Special Offences Court sitting in Ikeja, Lagos, has sentenced one Abubakar Sani to one year imprisonment for the fraudulent conversion of N16,684,018.00.

The sentence followed Sani's guilty plea after exploiting a malfunction in the E-bill pay platform of Lorus Bank to illegally transfer funds.

The defendant, who was arraigned before the court on an amended charge dated April 30, 2025, pleaded guilty to the offense, thereby enabling a swift conclusion of the matter.

In her judgment, Justice Okunuga acknowledged that Sani was a first-time offender and did not waste the court's time by admitting to the

crime early. "The defendant, having pleaded guilty to the amended information and admitting the review of facts and exhibits tendered by the prosecution, is hereby convicted and sentenced to one year imprisonment with an option of N1 million fine," Justice Okunuga ruled.

During the proceedings, Fanen Anum, the prosecuting counsel for the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC), told the court that the fraud was uncovered in July 2024 after Lorus Bank filed a formal complaint.

The bank alleged that approximately 718 customers exploited a technical glitch on its E-bill pay platform to make unauthorised transfers exceeding their account balances.

The EFCC said Lorus Bank suffered a financial loss of over N1.13 billion due to the fraudulent activities. Sani was identified as one of the beneficiaries, having illegally obtained N16,684,018 through the manipulation of the platform.

NDM condemns AYCF's call for state of emergency in Zamfara

The NUJ has records of all practicing journalists in the state, but Mai Akwai Abubakar does not have a record with the union."
